The first system of the harp arrangement, measures 1-4. The music is in G major (one sharp) and 9/8 time. The right hand features a continuous eighth-note melody, while the left hand provides a steady accompaniment of dotted half notes.

The second system of the harp arrangement, measures 5-8. The right hand continues the eighth-note melody. The left hand accompaniment changes in measure 8 to a whole note chord.

The fourth system of the harp arrangement, measures 17-20. The right hand plays a continuous eighth-note melody. The left hand accompaniment consists of dotted half notes.

The fifth system of the harp arrangement, measures 21-24. The right hand continues the eighth-note melody. The left hand accompaniment changes in measure 24 to a whole note chord.
